PISA Code of Conduct

I understand the purpose of PISA Soccer League is to provide a fun, athletic activity for children that teaches sportsmanship, self-esteem, and teamwork. My role as a parent, player, spectator or coach is to promote those values, have fun, and help the children learn the game of soccer.

My conduct as parent, player, spectator or coach reflects upon me, business sponsors, and the league. I am responsible for promoting and maintaining order on the sideline. All concerns, disagreements and complaints about coaches, referees, parents or players, should be directed to PISA.

Referee judgments cannot be reversed and are not subject to appeal. Only coaches may approach a referee to ask for clarification on a judgment or a question about the rules. I understand that the referees on occasion may make errors in judgment or miss something that others see differently, and accept this is part of the game.

Improper or unsportsmanlike conduct or confronting a referee, parent, spectator, coach, or player either physically, verbally, or libel will not be tolerated and will result in removal from the field and possible action against the entire team; including forfeiture of the game and/or suspension/ dismissal of players, parents, spectators, and/or coaches.

For the health and safety of children, there will be no smoking, alcohol use, or dogs at any field or within the general area of the field which creates a nuisance or distraction to the game in progress.
