PISA Soccer Field Policy

Do's:

Have fun!

Always be positive.

Always allow the coach to be the only coach.

Support the coaches, officials, and administrators working with your child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.

Respect all PISA referees, volunteers, and officials.

Sit behind the dotted lines on the sideline; give the kids plenty of room.

Sit across from your team's bench up to mid-field.

Throw away all trash when you leave for the next teams.

Applaud good play on the field from your team and the other teams.

Contact the field marshal, head referee, or tournament director if any problem arises.

Don'ts:

NO pets, NO or smoking, NO drugs, NO Alcohol at the fields at any time.

No tents/canopies/sun shelters. This can be a hazard to other participants, as well as the metal stakes left behind damage the mowing equipment.

Do not criticize game officials.

Do not get into arguments with the opposing team's parents, players, or coaches.

Do not leave your other children unattended while enjoying the game.
